
The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

3. Receive a report from Brad Dill regarding properties being developed by the District and to review, discuss, and take action on related matters.
4. Approve the minutes from the August 9, 2021 regular meeting and the August 23, 2021 special tax adoption meeting.
5. Review, discuss, and take action on the District Treasurer's report and take any necessary action regarding the District's investments.
6. Review, discuss, and take action on paying the District's bills.
7. Review, discuss, and take action with respect to any pay applications approved by BRW.
8. Review, discuss, and take action with respect to any change orders or other construction matters related to the dispatch center located at Squyres Road.
9. Review, discuss, and take action with respect to any pay applications approved by Martinez Architects.
10. Review, discuss and take action on the payment of capital funding pursuant to the current budget forecast.
11. Receive reports from the Klein Volunteer Fire Department (the "Department").
12. Review, discuss, and take action regarding the Department's 2022 budget.
13. Review, discuss and take action regarding submittals by the Department of request(s) for necessary purchases related to the provision of emergency services pursuant to the service provider contract and District budget.
14. Review, discuss and take action to develop protocols for an electronic filing system.
